

Rabada delivers Super Over win for Delhi against KKR

New Delhi, Mar 31: Paceman Kagiso Rabada defended 10 runs in the Super Over to steer Delhi Capitals to a thrilling victory over Kolkata Knight Riders after the home side made heavy weather of a run chase here Saturday.

He was caught in the penultimate over, edging one off Locke Ferguson while going for a big shot.

Shaw shared a 89-run stand with his skipper Shreyas Iyer (43 off 32). The Capitals made it tough for themselves in the last over with Rishabh Pant and others failing to take the side past the finish line.

Rahul powers Kings XI Punjab to eight-wicket win over Mumbai Indians

Mohali, Mar. 31: K L Rahul played the role of a sheet anchor to perfection as Kings XI Punjab returned to winning ways with a comfortable eight-wicket victory over Mumbai Indians in an IPL encounter here Saturday.



KL Rahul scored an unbeaten 71 off 57 balls

The 15th over bowled by Hardik Pandya swung the match decisively in KXIP's favour with 19 runs coming off it.

Once the pressure was off, Rahul hit the ever-dependable Jasprit Bumrah for successive fours to literally close the match. Gayle (40, 24 balls)

batted in a manner only he can as he cleared his front leg and hit those towering sixes before Pandya brothers joined hands to send him back to the dug-out after an

opening stand of 53.

Gayle failed to get required elevation off a Krunal delivery and Hardik caught him in the deep. Rahul was barely into double figures when Gayle got out.

The next partnership was equally interesting as Agarwal (43, 21 balls) was in great nick during the 64 runs that he added with his close buddy Rahul in only 6.1 overs.

Pandya brothers had a dismal day with the ball as Krunal gave away 43

runs in his four overs and Hardik 39 runs in three overs.

While he was a disappointment with the ball, Hardik once again provided the final flourish after yet another middle-order collapse as Mumbai Indians managed 176 for 7 after being put into bat. Quinton de Kock with a 39-ball-60 created a platform which the middle-order unfortunately didn't make full use of before Hardik smashed 31 off 19 balls to enable MI get past 175-run mark.

While De Kock hit six boundaries and two sixes in his innings, Pandya hit three boundaries and a six off Mohammed Shami.

Skipper Rohit Sharma also looked good during his brief stay at the crease, scoring 32 off 18 balls with five fours. He added 51 for the opening stand with De Kock.

Srikanth enters final, Sindhu crashes out at India Open

New Delhi, Mar 31: Former champion Kidambi Srikanth reached title round after a 17-month drought but P V Sindhu bowed out after losing a close semifinal contest at the USD 350,000 India Open here Saturday.

The event in 2017, blew four game points in the opening game to go down fighting 21-23, 18-21 to China's He Bingjiao.

The third seed will face two-time champion Ratchanok Intanon of Thailand in the finals Sunday.

"I think I need to be

more patient, I should have taken the first set, it was crucial for me but after losing it, I became a bit nervous. I made crucial mistakes in the second game," Sindhu said.

Srikanth had entered the finals of Commonwealth Games last year but he failed to reach the summit clash in any BWF Superseries or BWF World Tour tournament since his French Open win in October, 2017.

The 26-year-old from Guntur on Saturday eked out a 14-21, 21-

16, 21-19 triumph over China's Huang Xuanyi in an engrossing semi-final encounter. He will face second seed Viktor Axelsen, who beat India's Parupalli Kashyap 21-11, 21-17 in the final.

"It's been really long since I reached a final. I'm just happy to be here, playing the final again," Srikanth said. "I was trailing in the decided and I am happy to pull it off. I'm happy to come back in the second. It was about keeping the shuttle in. The crowd kept me going in."

It's been over seven years since the well in my colony was dug. I remember the contractor telling me that the ground was all rock, "Just dig!" I'd told him, and his men did. At ten feet, the rock became a harder variety, but I had urged them on. Today that same well which was finally dug at just twenty feet has supplied millions of liters of water and is going strong, despite a harsh summer approaching.

A group of seminarians decided to plant a small vegetable garden outside their hostel. It would consist of tomatoes, squash and cucumbers and the only financial investment required was for them to get a wheelbarrow, a pickaxe and a spade. The place didn't allow much space for a garden, but they were determined that a small, sunny area of the stone-covered dirt parking lot could work well.

However, permission would be needed and they feared that getting their superior's okay might be no

easy task. The three seminarians explained their idea to him. "You're wasting your time. Nothing will grow there," he said, but he allowed them to go ahead if that was what they wanted to do.

Reluctant permission is still permission and the three young men began work. First they put stones around and outlined the garden. Then they slammed their pickaxe into hard dirt, turning clumps of earth upside down. What they discovered just a few inches beneath the surface brought smiles to their faces: Dark, composted, fertile soil, likely the result of a former refuse area. Still grinning broadly, all three looked at one another and said in unison, "Ah, nothing will grow there!"

The garden, though small, turned out to be spectacular. In fact, tomatoes grew so vigorously they finally topped off at seven feet tall! Nothing will grow there indeed! Don't believe the words "nothing

will grow there." Especially when assessing your own life. As long as you are alive you can grow and change. You don't have to stay the way you are. Almost anything you desire can grow within you.

What do you need? Courage for a difficult task? Hope and optimism in your despair? Strength or persistence? Faith in something greater than yourself? Rekindled trust in other people?

What is it you need? Deeper understanding? A greater capacity for love? Inner peace or joy? Don't believe that nothing will grow there. When you assess your own life, consider it with more than the eye of a gardener. Underneath the surface lies rich, fertile soil laid by One above, waiting to nurture the seeds you sow. Even more than you can imagine will grow there if given a chance..!
